During the animation session, children will learn how to plan and film their own LEGO movie using StopMotion and edit their video with sound effects and music and see their story come to life! Zoom out of Earth and into space! Explore life in space and get to know the planets. Problem-solve the junk problem in space by using robots! Code Robot Dash to collect and deliver space junk to collection zones and get creative with designing of accessories for Dash to do his job.

Indulge in the fascinating world of symmetry in biology, nature and art! Explore the concept of symmetry through puzzles, art expression and reflection experiments! Dive into the sea and explore how sea animals protect themselves and understand the science of submarines. Unleash your creativity and create a diorama of the sea scape.


INSTRUCTOR

This half day camp introduces young kids between the ages of 4 to 6 years old to the world of robotics. Children will be building themed robotics projects and doing basic programming using Lego®. With an easy-to-use and graphical drag-and-drop interface, even the little ones can start programming robots! WeDo is an age appropriate version of the NXT Mindstorms/ EV3 that provides younger children with a wonderful head-start to learn all about cause and effect of programming while providing kids with multiple opportunities for problem solving whilst promoting creativity.
